Research it! Write it! Cite it!

Your opinion matters...
BUT you have to BACK it up!!

Opinion/persuasive essay about...

Decide what your opinion is and state it clearly.

"I believe that people should be allowed to keep exotic animals as pets"

or

"I do not believe that people should be allowed to keep exotic animals as pets"

Explain why you have that opinion.

I believe that exotic animals could be kept as pets because...

or

I do not think that people should have exotic pets because ...

"Because I like animals". THAT IS NOT A REASON!

You must be able to <u>explain</u> and <u>give examples</u>.

One reason that I believe an exotic animal is a good pet is...

THIS is when you refer to a source that you found while doing your research.
HOW DID YOU FIND OUT ABOUT IT?

Was it a website, a newspaper?

You must tell the reader where you got this example from!

It didn't just pop in your head!

You found the article on a website, a newspaper, a magazine - etc.

Even if I use a definition, I MUST tell <u>where the</u> <u>definition came from</u>. I did not just wake up this morning knowing the definition!!

According to the Humane Society, an exotic pet is defined as...

So...if I got the definition from the Calgary Humane Society Website:

According to the humane society, an exotic pet is defined as any animal that is not native to the United States, and is not usually domesticated, such as dogs or cats.

(Calgary Humane)

You must put the **FIRST PART** of the CITATION right after the info in PARENTHESIS


